#### Step by Step Design Guide

- 1. Select a dress bodice and skirt style.
- 2. Add additional details to the dress bodice and skirt.
- 3. Select a sleeve style. Add any desired trim details to the sleeves.
- 4. Select a headpiece style.
- 5. Decide if you want to do a one-piece dress or a two-piece dress.
- 6. Find out your velveteen color. Then choose a secondary fabric color and trim colors.
- 7. Select your actual secondary fabric and trims.
- 8. Decide on the placements and configurations of your trim. You may create a "trim set."

#### 4. Select a headpiece style.


Headpieces can be built on a headband or can wrap around the head and tie at the back of the neck with ribbons.

If desired, a veil can be added to any of the headpieces. Veils can be made so that they are detachable.



The pieces of a two-piece dress are represented in the drawings below:




The Costume Separates into a Doublet (Basically a jacket with the Zipper in the back) and a dress with a steeveless bodice.








